
Pediatric Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery

Pediatric Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery is a single volume textbook which provides a comprehensive reference of the broad spectrum of pediatric plastic surgical diseases. It is written by experts in the field, for pediatric plastic surgeons, fellows, residents, medical students and allied health care professionals. It gives a clear clinical overview of the major categories of pediatric plastic surgical diseases and covers 6 different parts: Craniofacial Disorders, Cleft Lip and Palate, Soft Tissue Deformities of the Head and Neck, Trunk and Lower Extremity, Upper Extremity, and Integument.

All 43 chapters are well structured and include introduction, diagnosis, management and complications. Every chapter ends with some key points and suggestions for further reading which is very nice. It is written in a clear way and supported with numerous full color illustrations and pictures. Furthermore, the book focusses mainly on surgical approaches. The chapters could be more referenced however. If you are looking for scientific reading this is not the book.

Overall, this book gives a nice overview of the different pediatric plastic and reconstructive surgical diseases, for all (trainee) clinicians and allied health professionals working in the field of pediatric plastic surgery.
