Online articles in full available to subscribers.

Starting this year all articles published in Rhinology will be accessible in the online version of Rhinology to all subscribers of the journal. After receipt of their payment subscribers will be send a password which gives them access to the full text of all articles in recent issues. At the present moment the site goes back to the year 1997, but this will be gradually expanded to previous years. Full articles, currently available for 2002, will be gradually added. The 2003 password will expire January 31st, 2004 and a new password will be sent after receipt of the subscription fee for 2004.

JUNIOR AND SENIOR SUBSCRIBERS

The Editorial Board of the journal has decided that beginning this year the journal will accept two new categories of subscribers: Junior and Senior. Both Junior and Senior subscribers will receive a password, which gives them access to the abstracts and full text of all recent issues but they will not receive the printed issues of the journal.

Junior Subscribers are recognised otorhinolaryngologists, other scientists in the field of Rhinology and those in training under the age of 32. The subscription price for Junior Subscribers will be \in 15,- Euro per year. For subscribers in European countries this subscription fee includes the junior membership fee of the European Rhinologic Society.

Senior Subscribers are retired otorhinolaryngologists and other scientists in the field of Rhinology who have subscribed to the journal in the recent past. The subscription price for Senior Subscribers will also be \in 15,- per year and again for subscribers in European countries this will include senior membership fee of the European Rhinologic Society.

In view of the overwhelming number of case reports being submitted, the Editors and Editorial Board have decided to only accept those where the following requirements are fulfilled:

- a clear description of a new disease entity, a very special observation, or several cases of a rare condition with a short but complete review of the literature,
- a limited number of high-quality and/or unique illustrations,
- a maximum of 3 printed pages including illustrations and references.
