

Corticosteroid responsive improvement in olfactory function in chronic rhinosinusitis

what does it mean for surgical patients?





- CRS patients with CROD are more likely to have greater improvement in olfactory dysfunction post-operatively
- This suggests corticosteroid responsiveness is a clinical predictor of preserved function and reversibility
- Potential use as a clinical prognostic factor
